

FVTFL Fall 2020 Season – Covid-19 Rule/Procedure Adjustments

All FVTFL participants are required to abide by the following rules:

- **MUST** read the “FVTFL Return to Sport Plan”.
- **MUST** read and sign the “FVTFL Covid-19 Participation Agreement” prior to participating in the Fall 2020 Season.
- **MUST** complete a wellness self-assessment and sign the FVTFL Stat Sheet to confirm that they are **NOT** experiencing Covid-19 symptoms prior to each game.
- **MUST** Sanitize hands upon arrival at the field and upon departure of the field
- **MUST** Follow social distancing protocols whenever possible (ie; while on the sidelines)
- Help to enforce social distancing for all spectators.
- **MUST NOT** share drink containers.
- **Must** arrive no earlier than 30 minutes prior to game time and leave no later than 15 min after the game has ended.
- **MUST** leave the field no more than 15 minutes after the game has ended.
- No more than 50 people will be allowed at a field at once.
- Divisions will consist of 4 Teams with rosters of Maximum 12 players per team. Rosters cannot be changed after the first game of the season. (This is to keep in compliance with the 50 person Maximum cohort).
- Stat sheets must be signed by all players in attendance. Paper copies will not be accepted but rather a photo must be emailed to fvtflstats@gmail.com

On the field of play the following rules will be enforced:

- Team benches are to be on opposite sides of the field.
- Allow the Referees to maintain social distancing from players (2 Meters).
- Football gloves are to be worn by all players while on the field of play (Excluding the QB).
- No Huddles or post game handshakes.
- Players must separate immediately after the play has completed.
- Players must vacate the center of the field after each play to allow the Referee to social distance while setting the bean bags.
- Only the officials are allowed to touch the field equipment (Bean Bags, Cones, Goalpost Pads).
- Offense will be required to get their own ball after a play has ended to avoid unnecessary contact of equipment.
- To avoid unnecessary droplet transfer, yelling at **ANYONE** on the field of play or sideline will **NOT** be tolerated and will result in immediate ejection from the game and the facility (Own team included).
- No Spitting allowed at the facility.
- Coughing or Sneezing must be into a sleeve or shirt collar.
